Will Kellogg was born in 1860. He didn't know that one day he would change our way of . His brother John Kellogg was a doctor at \*the Battle Creek Health Center in Michigan. Will worked very hard at his brother's health center. He was the \*accountant and manager and did everything else his brother didn't want to do. When John looked for new healthy foods for his patients, Will also helped him. They worked together and tried to make a new healthy bread for breakfast from \*wheat. They tried everything with the wheat, but nothing ( 1 ).

One day, Will made some \*dough of wheat as usual, and then had to leave it for a while. When he returned, the dough was not fresh any more. He decided to put this dough through \*rollers anyway. To his surprise, it came out as flakes, not a long sheet. When he baked the flakes in the oven, they became light brown in color. After he tried this a few times, he produced wheat flakes. He asked his brother John to serve the new breakfast food in the dining room of the health center. The patients ate the new breakfast food and loved it. It was 1894, and a new cereal was born.

Even after they left the health center, patients ordered bags of the cereal. By 1895, John and Will were producing 100,000 pounds of flakes every year and selling each \*ten-ounce box for fifteen cents. John was not interested in ( 2 ) after this new food business and left all the work to his brother as usual. Will continued to experiment with new foods for the next few years and produced a new cereal made from corn—he called it corn flakes!

In 1906, Will opened his own cereal company ( 3 ) the Toasted Corn Flake Company and started to sell corn flakes. By 1907, his company was producing 2,900 cases of cereal every day. Will increased sales of his cereal all the time and spent millions on advertising.

By 1948, the Kellogg Company had sales of more than \$100 million. Will Kellogg made millions of dollars, but he continued to live a simple life. He lived in a simple house and ( 4 ) to give most of his money to help others, especially children. In 1930, Will Kellogg started \*the Kellogg Foundation to help children. Will Kellogg died in (ア)1951, at the age of 91. He worked until the end of his life at the foundation. His company became the world's largest producer of ready-to-eat cereal as the result of an accident. People continue to eat cereals because all they need is a bowl, a spoon, some milk, and a box of cereal.

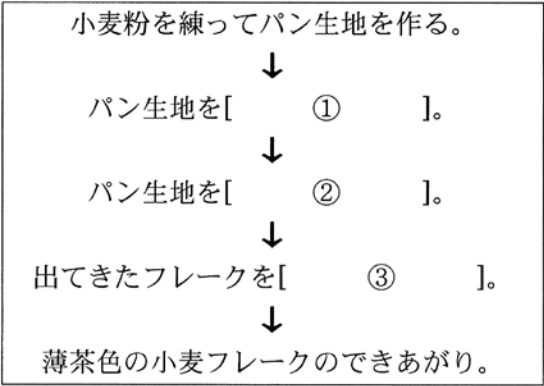
